No.Acd/12/2016/(pt)/ 3559 / Consequent upon decision of the Academic Committee meeting held on 26.8.2021 and duly approved by the Govt vide their letter No 17746 / SME Dt 16.9.2021 in respect of continuous and comprehensive evaluation of students the following clarification are made for the students, teachers and all concerned.

1. That reduced syllabus prescribed by the CHSE in each subject for the academic session 2020-21 shall be the same syllabus for the session 2021-22. The question pattern which was notified for Annual H.S Examinations 2021 shall be applicable to Annual H.S Examination 2022.
2. The Quarter-end examinations and 1st year-end examination, maximum marks for each such examinations, time to be allotted for each examination etc, are detailed in table I and II below.

3. For ex-regular students coming under Old syllabus

The prevailing syllabus has been in force from the Academic Session 2016-17, any ex-regular student irrespective of their year of registration, if enrolls to appear AHSE 2022, has to appear with syllabus as prescribed for the session 2021-22.

Further, in future; a student shall be examined in the syllabus prescribed for him /her for maximum three immediate consecutive examinations. Afterwards he/she shall have to appear the examination as per the syllabus prescribed for the examination of that year.

Detailed clarification:

- Every academic session is divided into four quarters. At the end of first three quarters there will be quarterly assessment of the students both in theory and practical/ project portion of the paper. At the end of the session, there shall be a year-end examination.

- A student shall be assessed in each of the first three quarter-end examinations based on the portion of the syllabus covered in that quarter only. A student will not be assessed from a portion of syllabus in a particular quarter from where he/she has already been assessed in the earlier quarter-end examination.

However, in each year-end examination the student will be assessed based on the syllabus prescribed for the entire session.

- The first three quarter-end examinations of class XII first three quarter-end examinations of class XI will be conducted by the respective higher secondary schools. Also the year-end examinations of class XI shall be conducted by the respective higher secondary schools.

The pattern of Question and mark distribution in Theory paper of Quarter end Examinations shall be as below:

Time Allowed – 45 minutes Full Marks-20

- Six very short Question (All compulsory) (Multiple Choice Type/Fill in the blanks/one word answer/one sentence answer type) (Each question requires not more than two minutes to write the answer.) $6 \times 1 = 6$
- Three short questions to be answered out of Four given requiring not more than 4 minutes to answer each $3 \times 2 = 6$
- Two questions to be answered out of three given requiring not more than 8 minutes to answer each . $2 \times 4 = 8$
- Question paper reading and understanding 5 minutes.

For Class XI year-end Examination question pattern be as is prescribed for Annual H.S Exam 2022.

Such papers will be evaluated at the institute level. The marks obtained by the students will be preserved in a format by the H.S School and will also be uploaded to the Council database. The format and the link for uploading/capturing the marks will be provided by the CHSE.

- iv. The year-end examination of class XII shall be conducted by the Council as usual in the same format as Annual Higher Secondary Examinations are conducted by it. The syllabus for the year-end examination will be the entire course prescribed for class XII only.
- v. The marks secured by students throughout his/her career at Higher Secondary level shall be recorded by the Higher Secondary School in the format to be prescribed by the CHSE.
- vi. **In case of any exigency, in which the Annual H.S Examination cannot be held partly or wholly, the marks secured by the students in their term-end/quarter-end examinations after due moderation may be taken for consideration for declaration of annual result. CHSE will decide the modalities in this matter in appropriate time.**
